# Independent Provider Extracurricular High School Lettering Program Example

NOTE: The following are only suggestions for your school's letter program. This document is a template to be used by your team's coach to define their preferences for a lettering program recommendation for school officials to consider for approval. Each school is responsible for creating and approving their own lettering program.

School name, in conjunction with the Iowa State High School Clay Target League, has developed an Independent Provider Extracurricular Lettering Program for shooting sports. The requirements set forth in this policy are meant to be an equivalent to other varsity lettering requirements for this high school's sports.

# SUGGESTED OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

- 1. To offer high school athletic status to shooting sport student athletes.
- To recognize the accomplishments and time commitment of shooting sport student athletes with a varsity letter award to those
  who meet the requirements as defined by the high school. Official high school athletic recognition is important to college
  applicants.

## SUGGESTED QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR LETTERING

To be eligible for the Independent Provider Extra Curricular Lettering Program, the shooting sport student athlete must meet the following criteria:

#### 1. ADMINISTRATION

Athlete must be a student of School name and ISD# in grades 9-12.

Home schooled athletes in this school district are also eligible.

Athlete must abide by School name and ISD# and Iowa State High School Clay Target League activity requirements.

Athlete must adhere to all school district rules, policies and requirements concerning student activities including, but not limited to, attendance, conduct, scholastic standing and other eligibility requirements.

Athlete must submit all necessary documentation and associated fees to the school's lettering coordinator by date.

## 2. PERFORMANCE

Athlete must average 20 points or more per round in competition play at the end of the season.

Athlete must not miss any competition weeks during the season.

Athlete may participate in the State Tournament.

## 3. LONGEVITY

Athlete must participate consistently with the team for 3 years or more.

If a student athlete fails to adhere to the Qualification and Requirements for Lettering, the athlete forfeits the right to letter for that season.

# SUGGESTED PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

School name letters, shooting sport patch, bars, and certificate will be awarded to the qualifying recipients at event name and date. In addition participating students will be invited to be included in the clay target team photo for the school's yearbook.
